Open Catalog Interface (OCI): the streamlined e-procurement solution

The OCI interface means you no longer need to record your item data manually in your ERP system when ordering via the EHG online shop.



You can transfer the orders with all product information relevant to you into your ERP system at the push of a button. The order itself will be made

Electronic Data Interchange (EDI): for fully digitised order processes

The EDI interface enables you to complete the entire order process paper-free and directly from your ERP system. The automated operation shortens the process from order through to incoming goods and frees up time for your staff to dedicate to other, productive activities.

Machine-readable documents, such as order confirmations, delivery notes, and invoices, are always updated and available in your ERP system. They can be used for analysis, statistical assessments and automated actions. Authorised persons can access these at all times, if required.

Orders can be decentralised and assigned their own item numbers, if requested.

The type of digital connection and process steps affected are defined.




2. Definition of interfaces and data exchange
